

Science Safety Rules

Plan ahead.

Know the steps in the experiment. Learn how to use equipment. Ask any questions before you start.

Be neat and organized.

Keep your work area clean. Secure long hair or loose clothing.

Report any accident right away.

Anything spilt ... Anything broken ... Anyone injured

Protect your eyes and skin.

Wear safety goggles when required.

If you get something in your eyes, tell an adult right away. If you get any substance on your skin, wash it off.

No eating or drinking during a science experiment.

Be careful with electric cords and equipment.

Put cords in a safe place.
Don't pull out plugs by pulling on cords.

Be careful with hot items.

Clean up afterwards.

Put everything away. Wipe down your work area. Wash your hands.
